
Area Map

Overview

Iiyama Station is a main starting point for transportation to the Shin-etsu Trail and the surrounding areas. In the area around the station are stores, restaurants, accommodations, most within walking distance, so you can easily get the supplies and information you'll need for your hike. Iiyama City is known as a castle town, but it also has a large number of temples scattered throughout the city. It can be a lot of fun to take a walk through the city and come in contact with history and culture.

Trains

Hokuriku Shinkansen Line, Iiyama Station:

The Hakutaka trains stop at this station; the Kagayaki trains do not.

Iiyama Line, Iiyama Station:

Trains depart and arrive approximately once every hour.

Buses

Iiyama Municipal Bus: 0269-69-3111

Taxis

About five taxis are normally waiting in front of Iiyama Station. If none are available, contact the Iiyama Station Tourist Information Center.

Supplies/Supermarkets

Tsuruya: 0269-67-9011 / 9:30-20:00; Sundays 9:00-20:00; irregular holidays

Located in front of Iiyama Station, it provides a wide range of groceries, and has its own bakery providing fresh baked bread.

Delicia: 0269-81-3210 / 9:00-21:00

About five minutes on foot from Iiyama Station. Provides general grocery items; smaller than Tsuruya or

Beisia.

Beisia: 0269-67-2111 / 9:00-20:00

Between 20 and 30 minutes by foot from Iiyama Station. Comprehensive store providing food, clothing and daily necessities. Cainz Home, a home center, is also located here, providing some outdoor products as well.

Restaurants

There is a wide variety of restaurants in the city, featuring Japanese, Chinese and Italian food, as well as izakaya Japanese pubs. Note that many are closed on Wednesdays. For more information, or if there are any issues, please contact the Iiyama Station Tourist Center.

Accommodations

Hotel Hoteiya: 0269-62-3128

A hotel dating back to the Edo period (1603 to 1867). Located in the Honmachi shopping district, about a

10-minute walk from Iiyama Station.

Onyado Iiyama-kan: 0269-62-2022

An inn founded in the Meiji era (1868 to 1912). Located about 10 minutes on foot from Iiyama Station, it's

possible to reserve without an evening meal. The host is quite familiar the Shin-etsu Trail.

Noble Iiyama: 0269-62-0165

A business hotel about 15 minutes on foot from Iiyama Station, and three minutes on foot from Kita-Iiyama

Station on the Iiyama Line. Choice of stay with or without meals.
