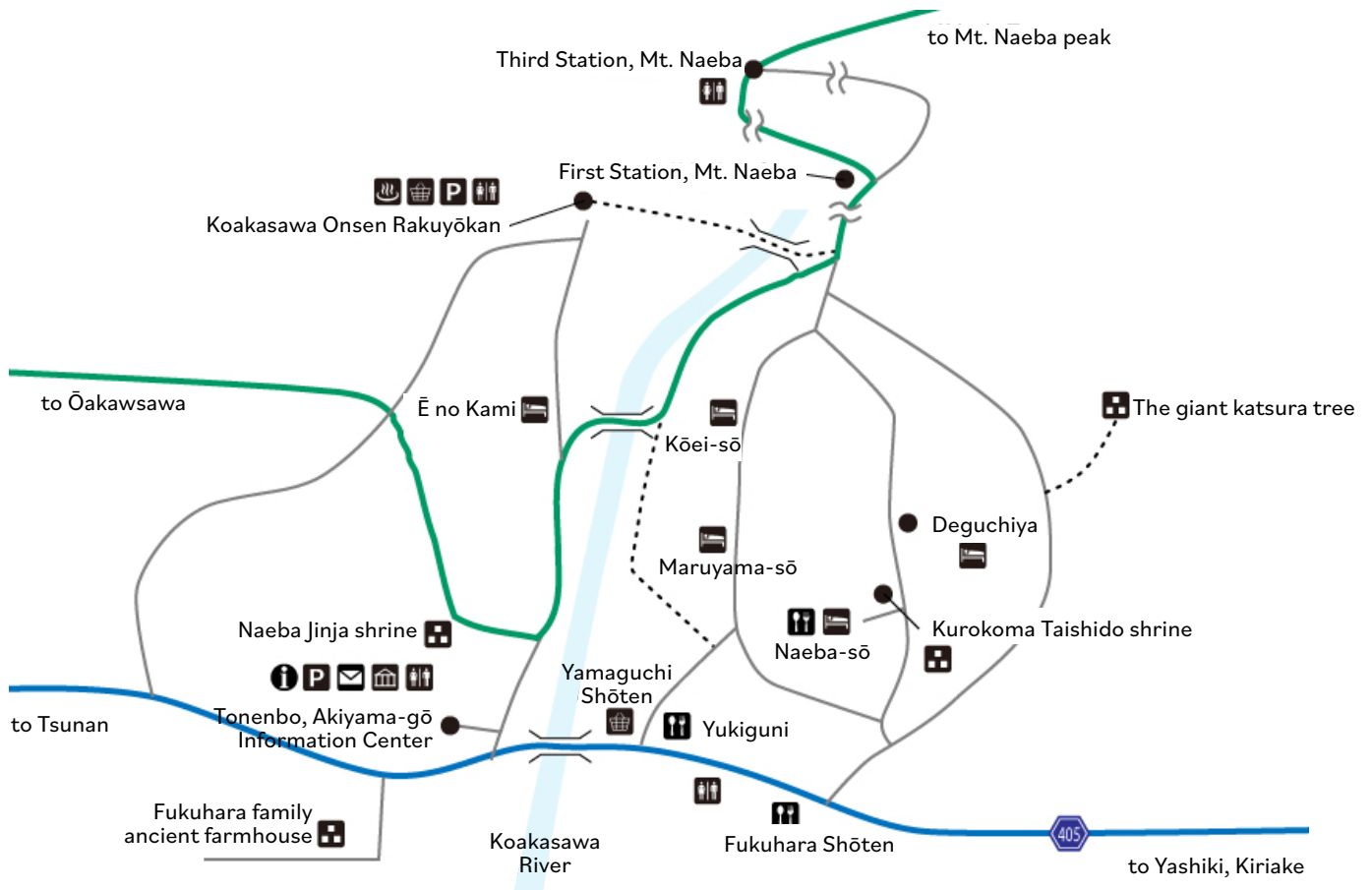


## Area Map

### Koakasawa



#### Overview

The base for climbing Mt. Naeba, and an area rich in the history and culture of Akiyama-gō. Hikers carrying tents may also wish to stay at a local inn to take a break in their journey.

#### On-demand bus

Minami-Echigo Kankō Bus: 025-765-3647 (Tsunan office)  
Morimiya Kōtsū: 0269-87-2736

The buses above can be used from Tsunan Station, but the following transfers are required:

- Minami-Echigo Kankō Bus from Tsunan Station to Jinmaroshi Chūō—about five minutes, then walk five minutes to the Tsunan Town Office;
- Minami-Echigo Kankō Bus from Tsunan Town Office to Mitama, about 15 minutes;
- Morimiya Kōtsū on-demand taxi from Mitama to Koakasawa, about 15 minutes; reservation required one day before trip.

Although technically an inn, meals are available. Serves the Akiyama-gō specialty Hayasoba.

Yukiguni (currently closed): 11:00-15:00

Serves daily lunches featuring local ingredients. On Friday and Saturday nights it transforms into an izakaya pub.

Fukuhara Shōten (currently closed):

Serves yaki-dango, grilled right in the store. Sells a variety of souvenirs.

Koakasawa Onsen Rakuyōkan: 025-767-2297 / 10:00-18:00; closed Wednesdays except in July, August and October
